Certificate in Economic Principles

Today, we face a turbulent global environment with major shifts happening in markets, geopolitics, technology, climate and economics. The times ahead will likely be radically different from those we've experienced in our lifetimes — but similar to those that have happened many times before throughout history.

In this programme, you will build a practical understanding of how the Economic Machine works, including short-term and long-term cycles, bubbles and crises, and the fundamental forces driving economic performance, policy and market outcomes. Steeped in the lessons from history, we examine how to separate out the noise and navigate a changing world order.

Emerge with a new viewpoint and develop your own principles for understanding the direction of global markets.

Certificate in Investment Principles

When building portfolios, investors need to understand the fundamental drivers of investment performance to build a robust and resilient portfolio for today's conditions.

In this programme, you will learn about the investment principles underpinning the approach pioneered by Ray Dalio and Bridgewater Associates, including the All Weather portfolio. Understand what drives the performance of assets and investment strategies and how to design effective beta and alpha portfolios. Explore in detail the mechanics of return, risk, and diversification, and apply the principles by engineering portfolios and stress-testing performance across a wide range of economic and market environments.

You will also have the opportunity to directly put your learning into practice by building custom portfolios using practical tools based on Bridgewater's renowned Risk Budget Tool (RBT), and stress-test your portfolio through a wide range of historical bubbles and crises.
