REQUIREMENTS

- A good bachelor's degree
- At least 2 years of work experience
- Competitive GMAT or GRE score
- TOEFL score: > 100 or IBT ELTS score: > 6.5, if English was not the medium of instruction used at the undergraduate level

Shortlisted candidates will be required to attend an admissions interview.
