*Fees, Accreditation and Subsidies

This programme is accreditated by the IBF. Singaporeans and Permanent Residents (below 40 years old), and physically based in Singapore will enjoy funding subsidy of 50% upon successful completion of the programme.

To make CFI accessible to the undergraduate segment, a concessionary course fee of \$1,188 will be applicable instead of the standard fee of \$2,592. All fees are subject to prevailing GST. In addition, qualified students are eligible for a WMI Study Award of \$500 upon successful completion. Together with IBF funding support and WMI Study Award, the nett fee payable would be as low as \$138.
