The Certificate in Philanthropy and Social Impact for Greater China Markets equips professionals with the insights and tools needed to navigate this dynamic landscape.

Participants will explore the motivations and strategies behind philanthropic giving among Greater China families, understand the role of Singapore as a philanthropic hub, and gain fluency in advising clients with cultural sensitivity. The course also delves into strategic giving vehicles, legal and ethical considerations, and emerging global models of philanthropy.

Led by Professor Tony Gao, Associate Dean, Institute of Philanthropy, Tsinghua University, this intensive two-day programme offers a rare opportunity to learn from cutting-edge research and practical experience at the intersection of family enterprise and strategic philanthropy across Greater China.

- Understand the regulatory environment, i.e. tax, cross-border giving regulations, and reputational considerations.
- Learn best practices for transparent, ethical philanthropy.

Tony (Hao) Gao brings over a decade of leadership at the intersection of family enterprise, philanthropy, and sustainable finance in China. He is also a Temasek Fellow, bringing a regional lens to Chinese philanthropy and wealth trends. His global engagement includes being a member of the World Economic Forum's Global Future Councils and Expert Network.

In addition to his academic roles, Tony serves on the boards of the China Charities Aid Foundation for Children and the New Hope Group, giving him hands-on insight into philanthropic practice and governance in China. He also contributes to thought leadership through positions at the Society of Trust and Estate Practitioners (STEP) and the Wealth Management Journal. Tony also advises Chinese and international government bodies and is featured in prominent media outlets such as CNBC, Bloomberg, and The Economist.

Tony holds a Ph.D. in Management Science from Tsinghua University, and degrees in Economics and Automation Engineering from Peking University and Tsinghua University, respectively.

高皓现任清华大学公益慈善研究院副院长、五道口金融学院全球家族企业研究中心主任、绿色金融研究中心副主任，亦为新加坡财富管理学院淡马锡学者及访问教授。

他先后担任世界经济论坛全球未来理事会理事、中国人民银行研究局第三方专家组组长、全国工商联智库委员会委员、中国企业改革与发展研究会理事、中国商业史学会华商专业委员会副主任、中华遗嘱库学术委员会副主任、国际信托与资产规划学会 (STEP) 中国理事/公共政策委员会主席、《财富管理》联席主编等。

研究领域为家族企业、财富管理及绿色金融，在国内外核心学术/财经期刊发表200多篇论文或案例，出版9部学术专著，发表11篇哈佛案例，入选中国知网“高被引学者”前1%，主持中国人民银行、国家发展改革委、教育部、商务部、民政部、国家金融监管总局、盖茨基金会等多个研究课题。

先后担任多家世界500强企业、大型金融机构和公益慈善基金会的独立董事、理事或专家顾问，多次获得中国中央电视台、CNBC、Financial Times、Economist、Bloomberg、商业周刊、财新等国内外媒体采访报道。

清华大学工学学士、北京大学经济学学士、清华大学管理学博士、金融学/经济学博士后。哈佛商学院公司董事证书获得者。
